

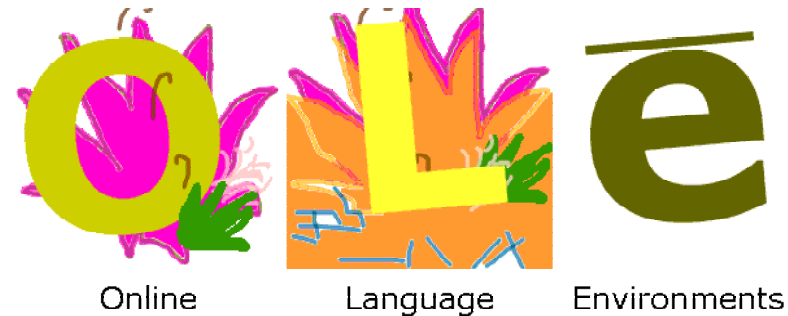
### Accessing OLE on Campus

### Tips and Hints

- After recording a message, you can listen to it and re-record the message as many times as you like before posting it.
- Try different placements of the web camera to find what will give you the best results.
- Lighting is important when recording the video. Do not have a strong light behind you when recording the video. A light coming from the left or right will help to provide contrast.
- Test the microphone recording level before posting a message to be sure that the sound is of good quality. The recording level can be adjusted both on your computer and on the OLE Board.
